August's American Women Quarter-Jovita Idar

August's American Women Quarter features Jovita Idar. Born in 1885 in Texas, she was a teacher, journalist, and civil rights worker. She fought to end the inequalities that Mexican-Americans were facing. She helped to found the *El Primer Congreso Mexicanista* (First Mexican Congress) to fight inequality and racism. Her work started in teaching

but moved to journalism to help make change by working at *La Cronica*, a newspaper that was a voice for Mexican and Tejano rights. She also served as first president of the League of Mexican Women which was founded in October 1911 in Laredo Texas. Jovita's quarter is released on August 15.
