GOING NORTH ON SUNNYVALE/SARATOGA RD -
TURN LEFT ON REMINGTON DR, RIGHT ON SPINOSA DR,
THEN STRAIGHT INTO THE LAS PALMAS PARK PARKING LOT

GOING SOUTH ON MATHILDA AVE. - AFTER CROSSING THE EL
CAMINO, IT TURNS INTO SUNNYVALE/SARATOGA RD, RIGHT ON
REMINGTON DR, RIGHT ON SPINOSA DR, THEN STRAIGHT
INTO THE LAS PALMAS PARK PARKING LOT
