Club President Fred D. called our meeting to order at 7:32 PM. Fred welcomed everyone. There were nine board members and no guests present.

Recording Secretary Lyle Okamoto reported nothing new.

Corresponding Secretary Al Lo received the usual mail plus an inquiry from Eureka about club medals and a returned letter addressed to Joe S. Al will take care of the club medals inquiry.

Treasurer Gary gave the Treasurer's Report. All is well.

Historian Harold W. reported nothing new. President Fred D. thanked Harold for his August talk, "Time Travelling".

Curator Gary reported nothing new.

Program Chair Emile M. was absent. September will be our SeptemberFest Party. Our club will provide Togo's sandwiches. Fred D. and Greg J. will bring soft drinks. Al Lo will call Katherine R. for potato and macaroni salads. Club members will be asked to bring desserts and veggie trays.

Coin Press Editor Allison P. reported that all was good. Allison was asked to announce SeptemberFest in our newsletter. Also, dues are due.

Youth Advisor Gary reported that four youths participated in our Youth Drawing at our August 2012 general meeting. The kids were happy.

Picnic Chair Lyle Okamoto gave Treasurer Gary \$6 from the T. family. This was the last of the CCC/SJCC Annual Joint Picnic income. Treasurer Gary reported that all picnic expenses were in. Al Lo asked about our picnic prizes. A total of \$150 was spent on our picnic prizes. Martha D. also had donated six Indian Head cents to our picnic prize pot.

Banquet Chair Gary announced that our CCC 28th Annual Awards Banquet will be held on Sunday, October 21, 2012, at the Blue Pheasant Restaurant, 22100 Stevens Creek Boulevard, Cupertino. Gary had the Santa Clara Expo drawing prizes tonight. The prizes are one \$2.50 Liberty gold, one one-tenth ounce gold Eagle, and ten silver Eagles. The prizes cost \$828, \$350 for the \$2.50 Liberty gold. Gary turned over the prizes to Fred. Fred asked Gary about the money in the till.
