Boy Scout Merit Badge at CoinExpo!

Cupertino Coin Club/Silicon Valley Monterey Bay Council of the Boys Scouts of America (BSA) will be working in cooperation with Kyle Anderson of Diablo Numismatic Society in Concord/Mt. Diablo Silverado Council BSA/Troop 465 to run the BSA Coin Collecting Merit Badge workshops at Santa Clara CoinExpos each April and September. The hope is that this might continue to bring in new youth to our club, as it did with Alex T. back in 2012, who then invited numerous friends and their families. CCC Vice President Suzy T. will work with Kyle to run the April 21 workshop at the upcoming CoinExpo show. Future workshops at CoinExpos will be run by Kyle, CCC President Emile, and Suzy.

Apostle Islands National Lakeshore

The second quarter released this year features the Apostle Islands National Lakeshore in Wisconsin. The lakeshore was created by Congress in 1970 and includes 21 islands in Lake Superior as well as 12 miles of mainland shoreline. The park is at the center of the modern and ancestral homeland of the Ojibwe people. The lakeshore has sand beaches



and coves, sea caves, old-growth forest, birds, mammals, and amphibians, and the largest collection of National Register lighthouses and lighthouse complexes in the National Park system.

Medal Design Contest Rules

- The design must be on unlined paper in a circle of six to eight inches in diameter.
- The subject matter of your reverse design may be in the form of a single photo, postcard, or group of drawings in one design. Not all members of our club are artists, so the subject matter may consist of cutout pictures and the like.
- You may submit an explanation of your design.
- You may submit a maximum of two designs.
- The designer's name or initials may not appear on the design or design explanation. These will be added after the winning design is selected.
- If your entry is of a private, commercial, trademarked, or copyrighted subject matter, then you must obtain written permission from the rights holder. If permission is not granted, then the runner-up design will be used.
- The following information must be placed on the design: "47th Coin Show". Because we don't yet know the date and location of our 2019 show please insert a date in your design of Feb xx, 2019 and leave space to put the final show location.
- All entries may be submitted at a regular club meeting or mailed to the club at: CCC Medal Design, P.O. Box 448, Cupertino, CA 95015-0448.
- All entries must be delivered to the President by 8:15 PM at our April 13, 2018 meeting or arrive at our club's P.O. Box by April 13, 2018. The entries will be voted upon by our membership at our April 13, 2018 regular meeting.
- In the event of IDENTICAL design submissions, the first design submitted will be entered in the design contest.
- The winning design becomes the property of Cupertino Coin Club and will not be returned. All other entries will be returned. The Cupertino Coin Club Board of Directors reserves the right to modify the winning design to meet the requirements of the minting process. Any modifications will be cleared with the designer.
- The winning designer shall receive one copper medal as the winner's prize.
